1. On retreats, at lock-ins, or on mission trips –No guys in girls' sleeping quarters at any time (and vice versa!)

4. Follow curfew and all stated rules.

The Church Together Youth Ministry adheres to the following portions of the Seminole County Schools Dress Code. This notice is sent as a friendly reminder to all parents to be sure their youth are dressed appropriately for Youth Ministry Activities. Thank you.

Excerpted from the 2014 Seminole County Student Policies and Conduct Code:

DRESS AND GROOMING POLICY - GRADES 6-12:

1. All students shall wear shoes/footwear. Students must wear shoes that are safe and appropriate for the environment. Cleats, slippers, and shoes with wheels are not permitted to be worn to youth activities.
2. (a) Garments must be of a length and fit that are suitable to the build and stature of the student. (b) The following items are prohibited: halter tops, tube tops, backless dresses/tops, spaghetti straps, and tank tops. (c) Necklines of all upper garments must be modest. Low cut necklines are prohibited, and the cut of garments must not expose undergarments or cleavage. (d) Shirts must touch, at a minimum, the top portion of lower garments at all times. (e) Garments that are distracting or inappropriate are prohibited, including but not limited to those with see-through materials, skintight items, pajamas, trench coats, bandanas, rips/tears, printed profanity, or language/symbols/styles that promote the use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, gang-related or other illegal activities
3. a) Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered even while seated. (b) Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length. Rip/tears above mid-thigh that expose skin or undergarments are not permitted (c) The waistband of pants, shorts, or skirts must be worn and secured between the hips and the waist. (d) Undergarments as outerwear, pajama pants, bathing suits, cheer shorts, bike shorts and spandex material bottoms are prohibited.
4. Clothing, jewelry, and accessories shall not convey messages that are: crude, vulgar/profane, violent/death-oriented, gang related, sexually suggestive, promote alcohol, drugs or tobacco. Jewelry or accessories that pose a safety concern for the student or others are prohibited.
